March 8, 2023 Geneva - The FABEC OPS Theatre seminar programme was opened today at <u>Airspace World</u>. Under the title "Delivering Future Operations" CANSO and FABEC have jointly developed a range of expert presentations and discussions featuring subjects critical to the enhanced delivery of air navigations services, such as building resilience into operations, new operational concepts, workforce aspects and ensuring critical infrastructure.

The programme was launched by Alex Bristol, Chair of the CANSO Executive Committee and Skyguide CEO, and Claudio Clori, Chair of the FABEC CEO Board and Director ANA Luxembourg.
